Born: 01 September 1983. Was graduated from Lejeune High School in 2001. Enrolled at East Carolina University majoring in Physiology. Survived by his parents and a sister. AWARDS: Army Service Ribbon, Expert Marksmanship Badge with Grenade Bar, Marksmanship Badge with Rifle Bar, Combat Patch - 1<sup>st</sup> ID and 30<sup>th</sup> BCT. Enlisted on 08 NOV 2001 in A Co. 1-120th INF. At the time of his death SPC Desens was a Gunner on a Bradley Fighting Vehicle.

**SFC Earl D. Falcon, Sr.**

Born: 17 July 1955. Died: 22 June 2004 of cancer. Wife: Beverly of 30 years. Two sons and three grandchildren.
