### Bulgaria Outreach

We partnered with Convoy of Hope in an outreach in Bulgaria where we went to do prevention work, warning the women about answering ads in the paper. 70% of the girls April and the team sees in the district come from Bulgaria. While there we had the chance to share on two television networks, go into three schools, talk with the city council, present a movie in Bulgarian and share preventative measures in a town meeting.



As we were leaving a reporter said it was the event of the year because no one had ever come and told them what was really happening to their young women and give them hope to face the future. The day we left the pastor we partnered with said the city is already contacting him to help in other ways, our visit really helped boost his churches standing in the community.

### Incredible Help for the Ladies

Before I left Belgium I met a banker who is willing to help the ladies secure low interest loans to start businesses. Because of the situation they are in, they will be assisted in setting up a business plan, and given guidance in choosing a location and help as they proceed through the first months of the business. If for some reason the business fails, the loans will be forgiven. The ladies come to Belgium to work and this is the break many of them are looking for. It is wonderful to see how God is providing for all their needs.
